

# Kentucky Health Information Exchange Connecting Kentucky's Healthcare Systems

### What is an HIE?

- Health Information Exchanges (HIEs) are a tool that can be utilized by health care facilities to **close care gaps** and **aid in care coordination**.
- HIEs may be either public or private and at a state or regional level.

### How do you interact with an HIE?

There are 2 ways to interact with an HIE:

- **Push data** (e.g., public health reporting for regulation/Meaningful Use, formerly Meaningful Use, compliance)
- **Pull data** (e.g., obtain primary care visit summary; recent hospital encounter)
- Some Participants push and pull data, some only push data, and some only pull data.



## Kentucky Health Information Exchange Pioneering the HIE Marketplace



#### KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Since being founded in 2010, KHIE has connected with 100% of Kentucky hospitals, becoming one of the largest state-wide HIEs in the nation. Its unique position in the state government allows for one-of-a-kind collaboration across other state agencies.

### KHIE continues to be a critical tool for the Commonwealth:

- 6K registered ePartnerViewer users
- 15K data feeds sending and/or querying patient health data
- 1M immunization records sent to KY Department for Health
- 36.5M messages processed per month

### KHIE is a national HIE leader, ranking among statewide HIEs:

- 1<sup>st</sup> in number of overall connections (e.g., labs, hospitals, etc.)
- 1<sup>st</sup> in unique patients searchable in the MPI
- 1<sup>st</sup> HIE to receive CMS outcomes-based certification
- 2<sup>nd</sup> in number of participating organizations connected to KHIE

## KHIE Services Providing Access to Critical Health Data

ePartnerViewer

Access real-time historical and clinical data through a customizable health portal

Direct Secure Messaging Securely enables patient health information directly to another known and trusted recipient

#### Summary Continuity of Care

Electronically generate patient-specific clinical summary documents to enhance communications during transitions of care.

#### Event Notifications

Inform healthcare providers when a patient is admitted to, transferred, or discharged from various settings.

#### **Platinum Connection**

Support Cross-Enterprise Document Sharing (XDS.b) and Cross-Community Access (XCA) IHE framework standards to push/pull data between KHIE and the Participant's EMR/EHR.

Providers may view, share, and export clinical images to local Picture Archiving and Communication Systems (PACS)

#### **Electronic Case Reporting**

Report infectious diseases to the Department for Public Health through the connection with the Association of Public Health Laboratories (APHL) Informatics Messaging Service (AIMS)

#### **Direct Data Entry**

Manually enter data, which is instantly stored in the HIE.

Public Health Registries and Reporting Electronically submit data and reports as KHIE is connected to the Kentucky Immunization Registry, Kentucky Cancer Registry, Reportable Labs (ELR), and NEDSS

#### **Medicaid Continuity of Care**

Electronically generate patient-specific clinical summary documents that include appropriate Medicaid IDs with Medicaid Claims Data


# Public Health Registries and Reporting KHIE Streamlines Critical Public Health Reporting

#### TRADITIONAL CONNECTIONS

Historically, facilities would have to build connection points to individual registries.

#### **KHIE CONNECTION**

Now, KHIE automatically directs the facility's data to the appropriate location with one single connection.

In an upcoming enhancement, immunization records in the ePartnerViewer are going to show the **provider facility who administered the vaccine** and addition details regarding the vaccine. In addition, there will be a new **"Source" column to show where KHIE pulled that data from.**

### **Front Desk: New Patient Intake**

Streamlining Initial Information Gathering for New Patients

#### SITUATION

Hospitals often encounter significant challenges and bottlenecks when it comes to the intake process for new patients. These barrier can impede the efficient delivery of care, delay vital treatments, and contribute to administrative burdens. Hospitals typically rely on a multitude of manual processes, outdated systems, and fragmented information sources, leading to inefficiencies and potential error in patient intake. One such bottleneck is needing to wait on health records being faxed from other healthcare providers when requesting critical patient information. **Another includes not having the complete health data of recent procedures and immunizations.** 

#### **KHIE SOLUTION**

KHIE aggregates and summarizes patient health information in one centralized location, the KHIE Summary Continuity of Care Document including patient demographic, immunizations, procedures, and more

Unlike standard Electronic Health Records (EHR), KHIE has the latest paid Medicaid Claims information which is often used by healthcare professionals to fill in health and demographic information gaps

Regardless of the EHR used at a connected organization, KHIE collects real time patient health information from a multitude of healthcare facilities and displays it in an easy-to-navigate system

### **OUTCOMES**

The ePartnerViewer offers a comprehensive set of features designed to specifically address barriers and bottlenecks around information gathering. To overcome these challenges, the KHIE aggregates patient information in an easy-to-navigate and user-friendly platform, the ePartnerViewer. Healthcare staff can quickly access patient health information at the point of care, decreasing the time spent on searching for data and duplicative procedures and increasing the time spent providing care to the patient.




