

Childhood vaccines save an estimated 2-3 million lives worldwide every year, Vaccinations not only protect your child from deadly diseases, but they also keep other children safe by eliminating or greatly decreasing dangerous and deadly diseases that used to spread from child to child. A vaccine is a dead, weakened version of the germ that causes a disease. When children are exposed to a disease in vaccine form, their immune system, the body's germ-fighting machine, is able to build up antibodies that protect them from contracting the disease if /when they are exposed to it. 




