KY. GOVERNOR SIGNS LEGISLATION TO CODIFY IMMUNIZATION AUTHORITIES

Kentucky Gov. Andy Beshear (D) signed <u>HB 274</u>, which allows licensed pharmacists to administer ACIP-recommended immunizations to individuals five years of age and older. Kentucky becomes the 13th state to have made progress towards aligning immunization practices with the amendments to the PREP Act Declaration for COVID-19 Medical Countermeasures. NCPA applauds the Kentucky Pharmacists Association's successful effort to expand pharmacists' vaccinations to all Kentuckians.





LOOK AROUND, LOOK WITHIN MENTAL HEALTH MONTH: MAY

IMMUNIZATION FOR PREGNANT WOMEN: A CALL TO ACTION

Immunizations are an essential part of prenatal care, offering critical protection to women and their fetuses against potentially deadly diseases. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices recommends that women who are pregnant receive an inactivated influenza and a tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccine in every pregnancy (1).
